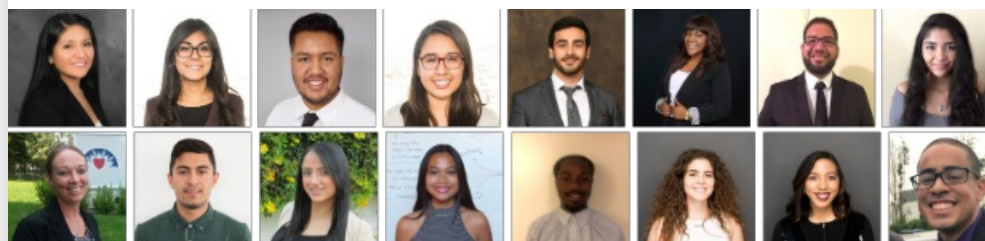
Providing Internships
