

One of Hosna's long-term goals is to "work for a company that is making a difference in our society." Hosna plans to attend graduate school after completing her Bachelor's degree at Cal State Northridge, earning a Master's Degree in Electrical Engineering.

On March 27, 2019, Dan Roberts, CEO of Oulette & Associates Consulting, Inc., interviewed Board Members, Marlo Donate (Farmers Insurance), Ron Guerrier (State of Illinois), and Cindy McKenzie (Deluxe Entertainment Services Group) on the motivation for starting STEM Advantage for his blog, The CIO Whisperers.

The piece highlighted a desire for finding and hiring diverse local talent resulted in the founding of STEM Advantage. Roberts noted, "They're partnering with less prominent colleges to find more diverse, often overlooked, candidates, and using tech meetups and other local events to promote their brands and meet IT talent.
