STEM Advantage Alumni Featured at MarinaHacks



STEM Advantage alumna Hosna Qasmei was keynote speaker for Cal State Long Beach's MarinaHacks, a female-centric, beginner-friendly hackathon, on April 30. She began by discussing what led her to choose a career in STEM and the challenges and difficulties she faced. Growing up, Hosna would help her father fix items around the house that broke. That was the first time she was exposed to problem solving and enjoyed everything about it.

She chose to go to CSU Northridge and get a B.S. in Computer Engineering after being part of the robotics team in high school. She emphasized the importance of students taking initiative in joining clubs and organizations at an early stage to instill networking skills and gain knowledge outside of typical class work, as well as taking advantage of resources and opportunities to find internships and jobs. Hosna had an internship at Northrop Grumman, then started her career as a Software Engineer at Teledyne Imaging Sensors before joining Proterra Ag, an agricultural technology startup. Hosna shared her biggest take away after working in the industry the last few years. She recommended students gain a growth mindset. In this field especially it is important that people believe that their intelligence and talents can be improved through effort and actions. Although they will experience many setbacks and failures, they can learn from them and overcome them to advance their career.


