Thank You, Angels Baseball

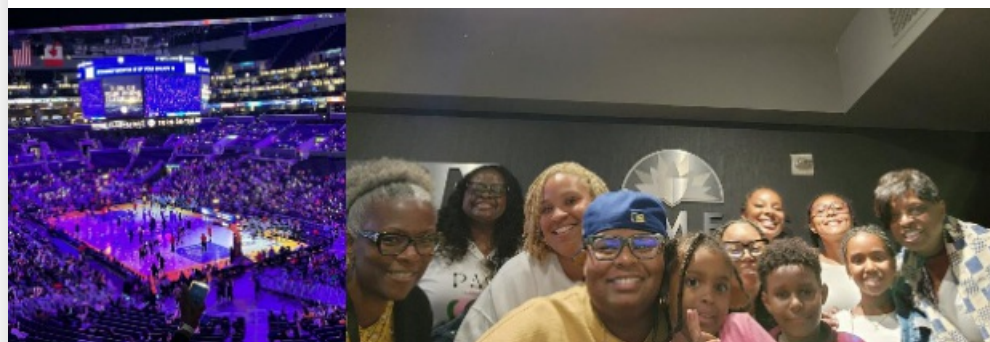
