STEM Advantage Campus Ambassador program



The STEM Advantage Campus Ambassador program is a new leadership initiative designed to strengthen our on-campus Scholar communities. Dedicated Scholars have the opportunity to serve as STEM Advantage representatives on their university campuses, increasing program engagement and supporting other Scholars—especially incoming Freshmen and Transfer students—through peer mentorship, resource-sharing, and campus-based outreach.

As a Campus Ambassador, students act as a bridge between STEM Advantage and their university community. Ambassadors promote STEM Advantage programs and opportunities, support scholar onboarding, share campus insights, host community-building events, and help our team stay informed about student needs and campus trends. This position provides Ambassadors valuable leadership experience and hands-on skills in communication, event planning, community engagement, and professional collaboration, as they support peers, build their resume, and expand their network.

We launched the program with Ambassadors at three campuses and will expand to all campuses we serve in 2026.
